

# HILLAM AND MONK FRYSTON CRICKET CLUB

## RULES

I. Subscriptions for members are:

### a) PLAYERS

An annual subscription of £30 is due on 1 April and is payable by all players over the age of 18 unless in full-time education. Players under the age of 18 in full-time education shall pay a junior subscription of £ ..... for the year. All subscriptions must be paid by 31 May. Only paid-up members will be eligible for team selection after this date. Where a genuine case of hardship arises, a written appeal should be made to the Club Secretary before 31 May, requesting the Committee to reduce or waive the appropriate subscription for the year. The Committee's decision will be final and binding. A player joining the Club after 31 July in any one season shall be eligible to pay half the annual subscription due for that season. Payment must be made prior to selection.

### b) ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP (NON PLAYERS)

An annual subscription of £15 is due for the year commencing 1 April and payable by all wishing to become members of the Club but not playing cricket. Membership will not be recognised until the annual subscription is paid.

### c) LIFE MEMBERSHIP

A once-only payment of £200 is payable by all wishing to become life members of the Club whether as players or associates. No annual subscriptions are payable by life members.

2. Match fees are £5 for Wetherby & District League games and £5 for all others. These are payable by all members over the age of 18. Players under the age of 18 shall pay a match fee of £2 in all matches played whether League or Cup games.

3. Members must, where possible, give the Club notice of their unavailability and must also notify the Club as soon as possible if they are unable to play in a game for which they have been selected. It is the responsibility of members to see the team sheets.

4. In the event of bad weather on a match day, members should ascertain from their Team Captains whether the match is on.

5. Members playing in home games should be at the ground 30 minutes before wickets are pitched.

6. The Club practice night is Tuesday. Members should make every effort to attend. Junior evening is Wednesday.

7. Members are expected to play a full part in the work on or at the ground.

8. At the end of the season trophies are awarded as follows:

*Winner and runner-up First Team batting*

*Winner and runner-up First Team bowling*

*Winner and runner-up Second Team batting*

*Winner and runner-up Second Team bowling*

*First Team fielding*  
*Second Team fielding*  
*1st XI Players Player*  
*2nd XI Players Player*  
*Clubman of the Year*

The qualification will be minima of 200 runs and 8 innings for batting and 20 wickets for bowling. In the event of no one reaching these standards, awards will be at the discretion of the Management Committee.

**9.** Any grievances or suggestions by a member should be put in writing to the Secretary for discussion at the next Management Committee meeting. The Management Committee will decide in the first instance if the matter should be placed before the Disciplinary Committee and the result communicated to the member concerned.
